Night of Power (Laylat al-Qadr)



- ♦ Laylat al-Qadr, literally "Night of Decree", also known as the "Night of Power" is the night when Muslims believe that the Quran was first sent down from heaven and the first verses of the Quran were revealed to Mohammad.
- Muslims believe that this is the most significant night of the year, when God gives blessings and mercy in abundance, prayers are forgiven, supplications are accepted and the annual decree (divine destiny) is revealed to angels who then carry out God's plan on earth.
- ♦ According to a tradition, rewards that result from acts of worship and praying on this night are better than 1000 months of worship.

Night of Power (Laylat al-Qadr)



- Pray for those Muslims who are seeking God for revelation on this night.
- Pray that Jesus will reveal Himself in supernatural ways.
- ♦ Pray that Christians in Muslim communities will boldly share the good news of salvation in this time when their friends are more aware of their sin and their lack of holiness
- ♦ Pray for Muslims who are unsure about their faith, trying to decide what to believe and whom to follow, that they realize that Jesus is the Way, the Truth and the Life.

Pray for our Muslim friends, colleagues and neighbours




God is our Fortress and Stronghold
